



AVOID FROZEN FIRE SPRINKLER PIPES!!

As the cold temperatures make their way in to Colorado this winter, we wanted to remind you of the importance of protecting and maintaining your automatic fire sprinkler systems to avoid the costly damage that broken pipes can cause.

There are some simple steps you can take to help ensure your fire sprinkler piping is protected:

- ✓ Check to make sure insulation is in place to protect piping adjacent to exterior walls, in attics, etc.
- ✓ Perform routine maintenance (i.e., empty drum drips on dry systems, check for proper antifreeze concentrations, etc.).
- ✓ Ensure that fire riser rooms or areas where fire sprinkler piping is housed are heated properly and heat is maintained continuously throughout the winter and spring months.
